- The tax base is the number of equivalent band D properties in the Parish.
- Column A are the figures that were used for 2021/2022. The Precept was increased by 3% in Feb 2021.
- <u>Column B</u> are the figures that were used for 2022/2023. The Precept was increased by 5% in Feb 2022. The Band D Precept charge on the Council Tax for Brown Edge Parish currently is £ 30.10 in this year. An increase of £1.43 from 2020/21
- <u>Column C</u> 0% Cost of Council Tax stays the same (+0.04) for residents. (very slight increase, negligible when rounded up)
- <u>Column D</u> 1% increase Household (Band D) pays 30p more/ Council Precept received would be £219.00 more (£25,265.00)
- <u>Column E</u> 2% increase Household pays 62p more/ Council Precept in received would be £489.00 more (£25,535.00)
- <u>Column F</u> 3% increase Household pays 90p more/ Council Precept received would be £714.00 more (£25,760.00)
- <u>Column G</u> 4% increase Household pays £1.21 more/ Council Precept received would be £974.00 more (£26,020.00)
- <u>Column H</u> 5% increase Household pays £1.51 more/ Council Precept received would be £1,219 more (£26,265.00)
- If the Council do decide to go higher than 5% increase: £26,500 would be an increase of 5.95% and £27,000 would be an increase of 7.94%.

#### 7. Budget Setting: (Please see attached Budget Document)

The Clerk presented the Budget calculations spreadsheet and Cllr. Turner also presented a simplified version to clarify solely the Precept expenditure and guaranteed income without grants or loans.

Following a discussion about having to save funds by cutting project spending, it was also discussed that the Council should apply for more grants to aid progress of village projects where possible. The PWLB Car Park Loan re-payments are to be taken from Reserves and not included in the Precept calculation.

# Brown Edge Parish Council resolved to request an 5% increase to the Precept for 2023/24 at a total sum of £26,265.00.

This will ensure the Council has some funds available to absorb increases in line with inflation. The Council will need to work harder to obtain grants to cover some of the projects previously earmarked with reserves or put these projects on hold.
